- Secure higher asset utilisation through sharing

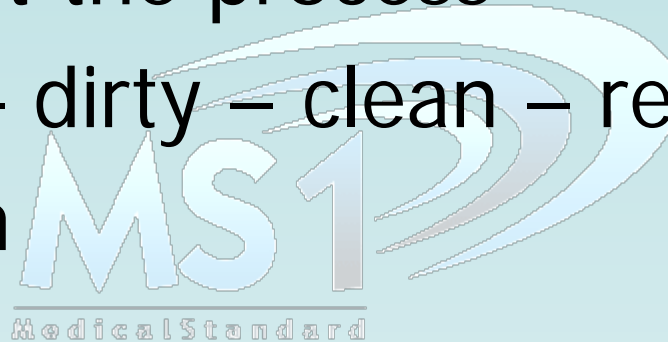


# Surgeon Choice But Tracked

- Build a plan



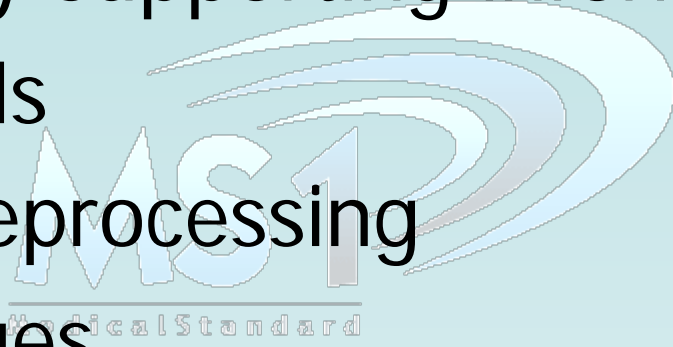
# Consolidation & Work Adoption

# Insurance Policy

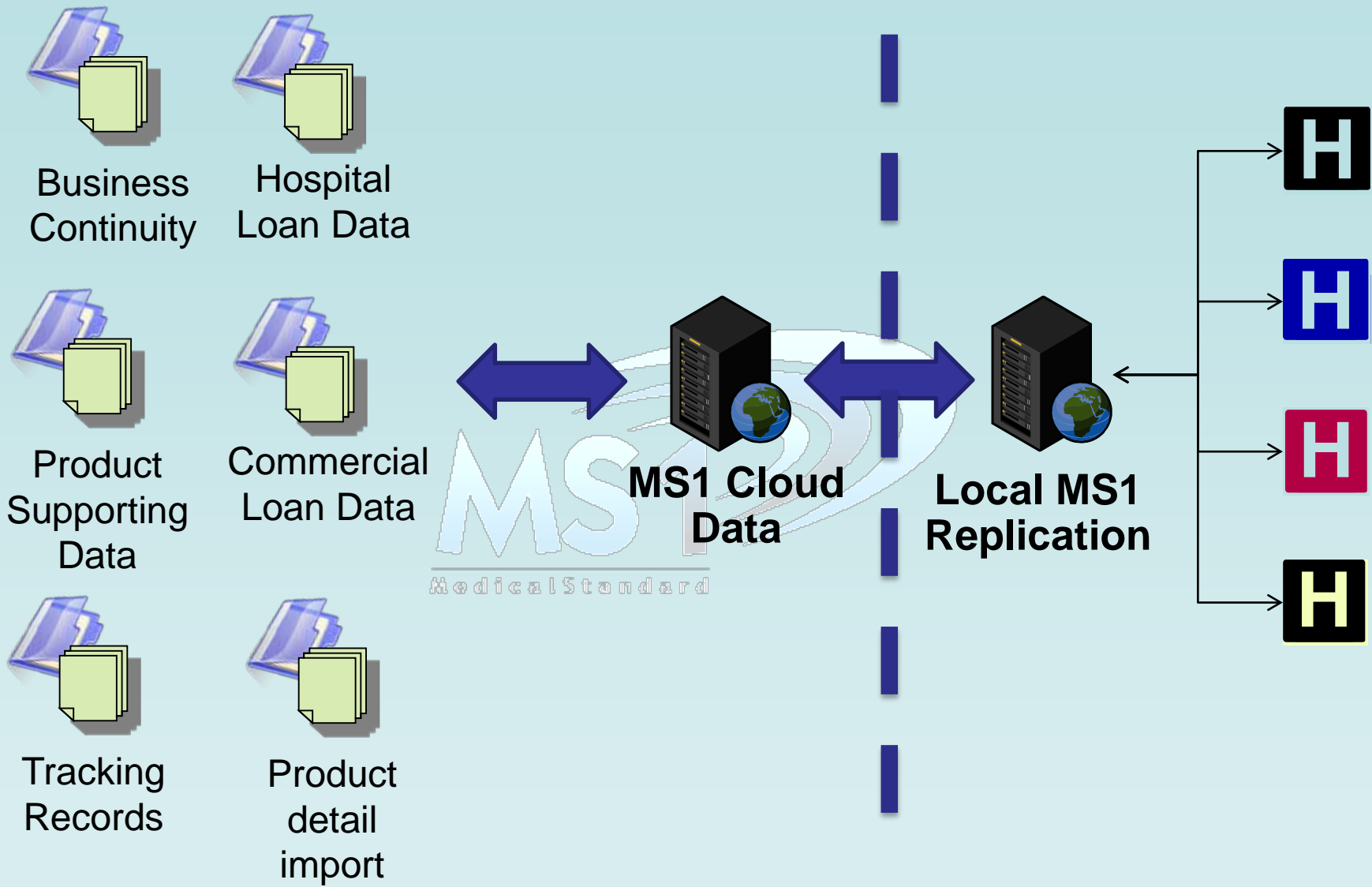
- Before a crash, insurance is an expense
